

## Executive Summary

Together with Metropolitan YMCA (MYMCA), the Exoro™ Team will be co-organizing the MYMCA Global ExoroGame™ Challenge 2008. Following the success of the National ExoroGame™ Youth Challenge 2007, be prepared for a bigger and better Challenge 2008. This event will be held within MYMCA premises. The MYMCA Global ExoroGame™ Challenge is an international event organized to allow local and overseas students to have fun, foster international relations and pit their entrepreneurial wits against one another whilst playing ExoroGame™. The entire Challenge will be held at MYMCA (Singapore) on the dates of 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> June 2008. There will be no participating fee.

## Challenge 2008 Structure

- Open to maximum of 4 teams per institution/organization, each team comprising of exactly 3 students from the represented institution/organization
- Competition will be held over a 3 day period (2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> June 2008)
- There will be 2 ExoroGame™ session each day (AM and PM shift), each shift will have 4 sessions running consecutively
- Each team will be randomly allocated and playing in exactly 1 session per day, and will have played a total of 3 sessions over the course of 3 days

- ExoroGame™ setup for each day will be unique to put participants through the ultimate test of their business acumens and adaptability

### **Free Demo Sessions (Entitlement)**

- Participating teams are required to be familiar with the rules of the game prior to the actual competition dates, as no game briefings and trial rounds will be conducted
- Local participating teams are entitled to attend at most 1 free demo session at MYMCA with other participating teams.
- Demo session dates will be announced shortly, availability on a first come first serve basis
- Each demo session will comprise of:
  - a) Full detailed game briefing (35 min)
  - b) 4 standard ExoroGame™ rounds (55 min)

### **Full ExoroGame™ Sessions for up to 40 pax (Optional)**

- Participating institutions can request for full ExoroGame™ session to be conducted in the comforts of your campus grounds
- Each ExoroGame™ session will comprise of:
  - a) Full detailed game briefing (35 min)
  - b) 3 standard ExoroGame™ trial rounds (35 min)
  - c) 8 standard ExoroGame™ rounds (130 min)
  - d) Full detailed game debrief and sharing session (40 min)

### **Challenge 2008 Prizes & Awards**

- Each of the top 3 teams will receive 1 institution trophy and 3 individual trophies
- Cash and in-kind Prizes totaling up to more than SG\$10,000
- Within each session, teams will be inter-ranked and score points based on their ranking in that session. The higher the ranking, the more points scored
- After all teams have completed their 3<sup>rd</sup> session on 4<sup>th</sup> June, the top 3 teams with the highest total points will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the entire competition

Amongst the overseas participating institutions, the one with the highest average points divided amongst its teams will be awarded the “MYMCA ExoroGame™ Challenge” plaque

### **Challenge 2008 Eligibility & Criteria**

1. Participants are required to have played and familiar with the rules of ExoroGame™ before the competition dates from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> June as no game briefings will be conducted. Free demo sessions are available
2. Participants have to be between 15 and 25 years of age before the end of 2008
3. Participants have to be English literate
4. This challenge is open to all institutions.
5. Participants should be interested to know and have a strong passion for entrepreneurship
6. All applications have to seek prior approval from the respective chancellor/principal's office as official representatives of the institution
7. Each participating institution must be accompanied by at least 1 teacher/principal during the prize awards ceremony on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2008
